LEMALA WILD WATERS LODGE (LUXURY)

Option 1

Lemala Wild Waters Lodge is located on Kalangala Island and lies on a unique private island mid-stream within the mighty River Nile. It is uniquely perched on granite rocks with dramatic and exciting rapids roaring all around. The lodge is a perfect place for viewing more than 1000 bird species that Uganda is so famous for, you might also spot giant otters and monitor lizards in the water. After the adventurous activities on the Nile, the lodge offers a relaxing and intimate location for couples and other guests looking for some quiet time. The sounds of the Nile waters are quite hypnotic and calming.








THE KIPLING LODGE (MID-RANGE)

Option 2

The Kipling Lodge is located on the Nile between Jinja and Kangulumira. It is an eco -friendly lodge built with support of the community. All construction materials have been source from Uganda. Its unique design is the result of an encounter between two cultures and the fruit of the fine work of local crafts men. The lodge has private bathrooms in each room, a restaurant that prepares tasty meals. It also offers other amenities like the swimming pool, golf, massage, Wi-Fi and many others.

BEST TIME TO VISIT



DRY SEASONS:

JANUARY & FEBRUARY & JUNE TO SEPTEMBER

Although it's regarded as a year-round activity, the best time to visit Uganda for gorilla trekking is during the country's two dry seasons: January and February and from June to September. Game viewing in Uganda's savannah parks is best at the end of the dry seasons - February and March and September/early October - when wildlife is concentrated around water sources.

WET SEASONS:

MARCH TO MAY

March, April and May see the heaviest rainfall in Uganda, with shorter rains in October to November. This doesn't affect your chances of spotting gorillas, although be prepared for a soggy, slippery trek! Waterproofs, and waterproof boots, are essential. It's also believed that the gorillas linger on the warmer, lower slopes during wetter weather, so your trek may be shorter.


